Types of Financial Aid

INSIGHT Tuition Assistance: Students may apply for need-based INSIGHT tuition assistance that reduces the amount owed per module. Students officially accepted into INSIGHT may apply for assistance before Modules One and Three begin.

IN-Service: All students are eligible for fee reduction in exchange for working in the INSIGHT office at a rate of \$10/hour. The accrued number of hours worked will be credited to the student's account at the agreed upon rate. Interested students should talk to the INSIGHT Pasadena Program Director for information. IN-Service is subject to the program's "INSIGHT Rules" document.

Other Means of Funding

Internships: All students may apply for an internship at the US Center for World Mission. Internships are usually support-based: students raise tax-deductible donations to the US Center to cover wages earned. Funds earned from an internship can be transferred to INSIGHT Pasadena and credited to a student's account. Payments on behalf of a student: If a relative or a church would like to help a particular student with his/her expenses for INSIGHT, they may make a non tax-deductible donation on the student's behalf directly to INSIGHT. Checks should be made to "INSIGHT" with the student's name in the memo line, and sent to the address listed above.

Working Part-Time during INSIGHT: Working part-time during INSIGHT is subject to INSIGHT rules. Desire to work during INSIGHT will not necessarily affect awards for tuition assistance. However, since tuition assistance is limited, students may decide to work part-time to cover expenses. Jobs at the campus cafeteria or local restaurants/coffee shops are often available and accessible.

INSIGHT Pasadena Financial Aid Process

Students who have been accepted to the INSIGHT Pasadena Program are eligible to apply for Financial Aid. Students must fill out the application and turn it into the INSIGHT Pasadena office by the due date. The student will receive a response within two weeks of the application deadline. The maximum financial aid any one student may receive is \$2,000.

Due Date: July 1st / December 1st

INSIGHT Tuition Assistance Standards

Students who are granted INSIGHT tuition assistance must maintain a high academic standard and continue to exhibit true financial need. Students may lose their INSIGHT tuition assistance by demonstrating personal financial irresponsibility, not attending class, not participating in discussion and/or not completing daily work.

The INSIGHT Pasadena Program Director reserves the right to terminate the INSIGHT fee assistance applied to future modules based on the above standards. Students who lose their INSIGHT fee assistance may regain it if they again demonstrate high academic standards and exhibit true financial need.
